SONG: "About Damn Time," Lizzo *see instructions in email sent from RJ*

- Couple Introduction
 - How would the couple like to be announced? **For the first time as husband and wife, RJ and Christina Crosby**

NOTE FOR GARY: Please see an Instagram reel that RJ sent to your Instagram account for Kicks Band as a private message. You would need to have this song teed up at 45 seconds into the song before you hit play, then as you intro them and start your announcement of RJ and Christina as a married couple, the song would be at the perfect spot and would say "It's about Damn time!" 😊 It will be GREAT if you can pull it off. Once the crowd settles for a moment after our entrance, then you can announce their first dance as a married couple, then they'll go directly into the first dance with Dave the Guitarist who will play "Cowboy's and Angels."

6:17 pm

First Dance

SONG: Cowboys and Angels - Dustin Lynch (Being played and sung by guitarist - Dave)**Jake to hand RJ his dad's cowboy hat.**

Couple to nod at guitarist when ready to end song

Important note for Gary:

-RJ will need a portable mic that you can hand to him after the first dance that is hot and ready to go so he can welcome everyone. After saying a few words, he will then intro Todd Duncan for the blessing and hand him the same portable microphone for the blessing. Once that is completed you can let guests know salads and dinner will now be served and you can start playing the dinner music suggestions.

6:20 pm

Welcome Greeting and Thank you by Christina and RJ (give mic to RJ)
RJ to welcome Todd Duncan to give blessing

6:22 - 6:23 pm

Todd Duncan to give blessing of the meal
